

MEMO TO: Mayor Clinton

May 4, 1962

Re: Temporary Emergency Hotel Licensing Board

As of 5 o'clock p.m. yesterday (May 3, 1962), 150 applications for licenses have been received by the Board.

Of these, 128 applications had been granted; 9 were being held pending receipt of needed additional information, and the Board had not formally acted on the remaining 13 applications which were received today.

The 128 applications which have been approved represent licenses for 3,696 transient rental units.

No applications have yet been received from any of the major hotels of the city.

(The foregoing figures were computed hurriedly by the staff so there could be slight errors, but it is believed they are substantially correct.)
