EV Charger-Only offers incentives for chargers installed at multifamily properties. Funds can be used to offset the costs of design, permitting, purchasing, and installation of outlets (Level 1) and/or EV chargers (Level 2). Related costs such as labor and materials are also covered. Final funding amounts may vary.

Make Ready (Available Later in 2023)

Make Ready offers incentives for projects that require new electrical infrastructure to accommodate EV chargers at multifamily properties. New infrastructure can include panels, meters, transformers, and upgraded distribution. Funds can be used to offset related project costs, including labor and materials. Final funding amounts may vary.
