ROADWAY ACTIVITY BEGINS SOON

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: ACCESS MAINTENANCE HATCH FOR UNDERGROUND 430 PIPELINE

Seattle Public Utilities (SPU) has started construction to repair portions of the large 430 Pipeline that runs four miles from Volunteer Park to Maple Leaf Reservoir in Seattle. The pipeline was built in the early 1900s and is part of the region's drinking water system.

Activity associated with the 430 Pipeline Improvement project includes opening an existing utility hatch in the roadway to allow crews to access the underground pipeline in your neighborhood.

LOCATION:

The 430 Pipeline Improvement project is a multisite project. Activity at this site will take place **near 6615 12th Ave NE** and occur in the street.

SCHEDULE:

Work at this site is scheduled to begin in early November. Crews will work at this site from 7 am to 5 pm in November 2022 and return periodically over the next year to access the 430 Pipeline for cleaning and repairs.

When work is occurring at this site:

- On-street parking near the work area will be restricted.
- Slowed vehicle traffic and staging of equipment and construction vehicles near the project area will occur.
